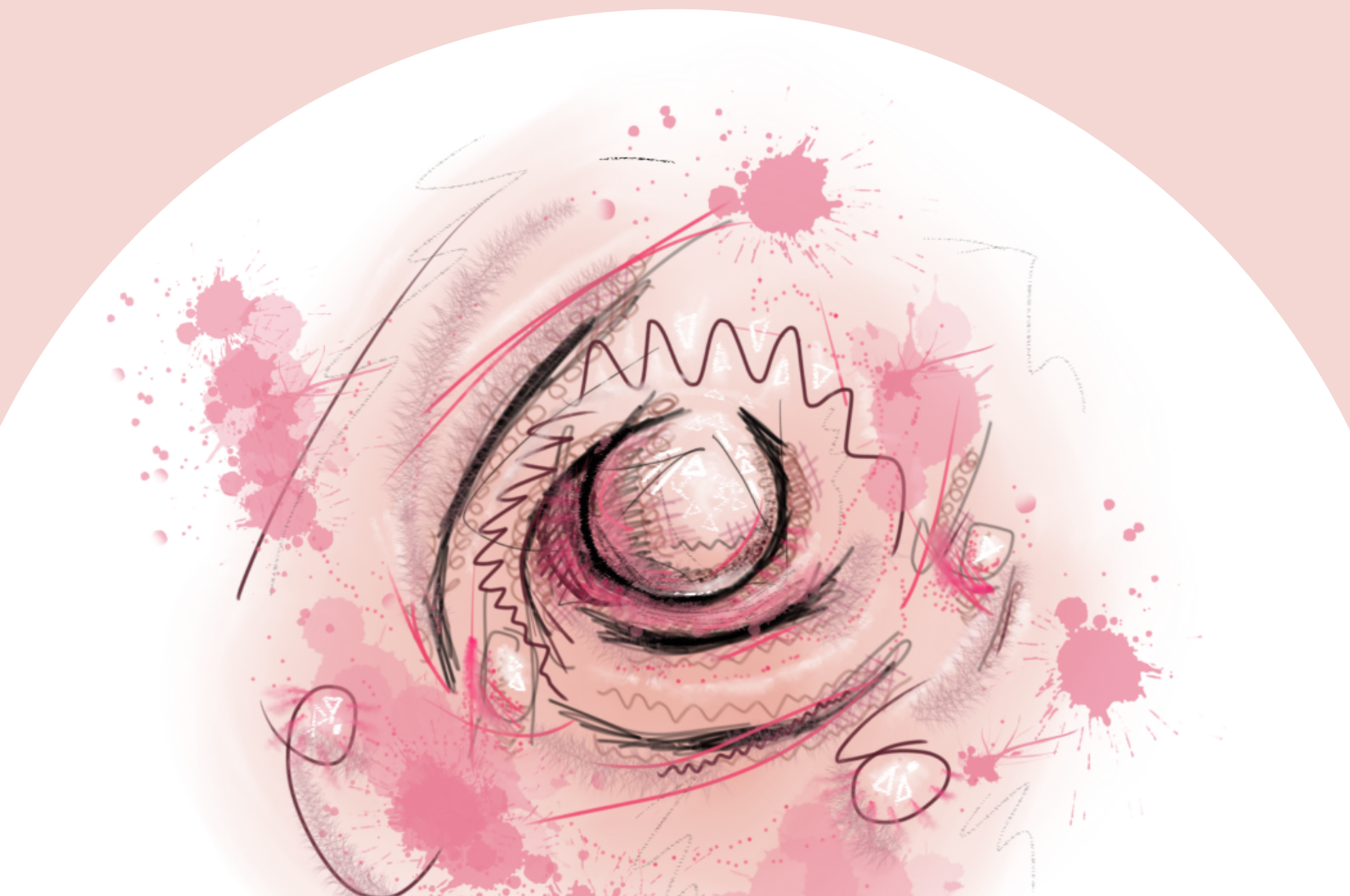

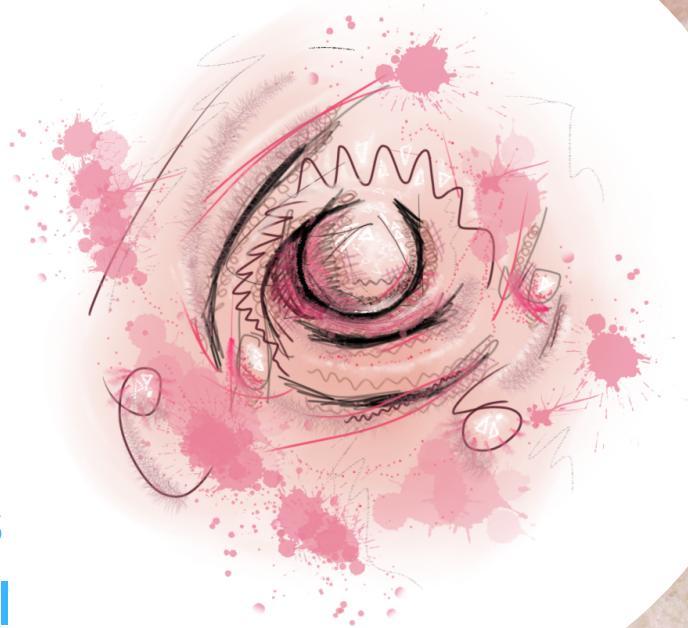
What is Medical Tattooing?

Any treatment that involves pigment entering the skin is classed as a tattoo.

When a person has an area of skin which requires colour to blend and enhance, or create an illusion of an element that may not be there anymore, a medical tattoo can help.

A medical tattoo can help with giving a person a new element on their body, this can include:

- Finger Nails where someone has lost a section of their nail or finger or toe
- A new Belly Button where someone has received surgery and need a new belly button, or to enhance the look to make it look deeper
- Web toes or fingers, a tattoo can create an illusion of separate fingers or toes
- New Areola or Nipple where a breast has been reconstructed following surgery

Treatments



Medical tattooing is available to all, the treatments available can be adapted to suit any skin condition, abnormality or result from surgical intervention.

Areola -or- Body Tattooing

Areola tattooing is a specialised treatment where a full or partial Nipple or Areola is tattooed to look like the replicate the real thing. Areola Tattooing can be carried out on completely flat skin, or over a nipple reconstruction. Areola tattooing can also help with areas of necrosis following any breast augmentation treatment. This affects all both male and females who undergo any surgery.

Scar Camouflage

Scar Camouflage is a treatment where pigment is implanted using the tattooing method to camouflage and blend two areas into one. Often this treatment can be used for small patches of Hypopigmentation, Scars, Necrosis and Skin Grafts.

Scar Revision

Scar revision is a technical term used for a treatment plan where we manipulate and rework the scar area. This treatment includes a number of sessions where a micro-needling process will take place. This is classed as controlled trauma and triggers the body to repair and rebuild itself without the need for tattooing. (However, tattooing can be carried out as the last part of the plan)

What to expect at your appointment

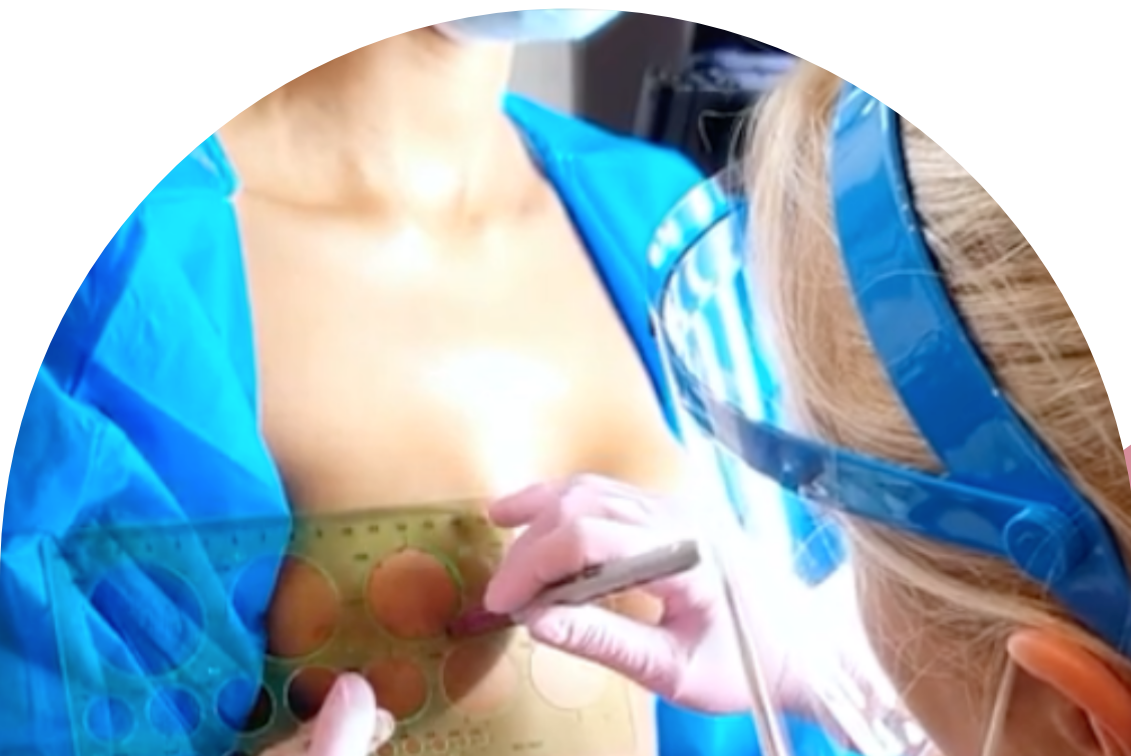
Kally's clinic is based in the beautiful quiet town of Hitchin in Hertfordshire. The clinic is comfortable and private which allows all visitors to feel relaxed and ready for treatment.

During your treatment there will be just yourself and Kally in the room, if you have a partner or friend with you they will be able to visit the town centre and grab a coffee while you have your treatment.

If you are local to Hitchin and are able to come in for consultation you can book in for a brief informal chat before you book, we do however try to ensure all frequently asked questions are available on the website, and we want you to understand you do not need to come in prior to treatment.

If you are confident with the process and would like to ask a question or show us an image without the need for a physical meeting you can send these over email or whatsapp.

All appointments are booked using our booking system which is set up to send you all the required forms electronically before you attend. This means we can ensure you are suitable for treatment and our records are kept up to date.

What to expect at your appointment

At your appointment Kally will run over your consultation form and ask you certain questions about any surgeries, timelines and healing processes. This enables Kally to build a better picture for your treatment plan.

Kally will offer you a privacy gown to wear while you are in the room, this is for comfort, however you can opt not to wear this if you wish.

Colours, shapes, sizes and elements will be discussed with you prior to treatment and Kally will discuss this with you. If you are having Areola tattoos and have an image of your pre-existing nipples please show this as this can help with design and colour selection.

Treatments can take around 90 minutes to 2 hours, Kally can advise you the approximate time at the beginning so you can organise pickups, car park and possible partners.

Throughout treatment you will be laying down on a very comfortable couch, we have the bed reclined slightly and we can offer you a pillow for under your legs if you have a back problem.

What happens after my treatment?

As soon as your treatment is completed Kally will take some photographs and ask you to sit up, she will offer you the mirror to take a look and then we will apply the aftercare dressing.


All after care will be explained to you at the time of your treatment, you will also receive written aftercare via email.

We advise all treatments will require a follow session. For Areola and other Tattoo's we would recommend 2 sessions.

For Scar Camouflage this may be 3/4 treatments, and for Scar Revision this may be 4/6 treatments.

When can I safely have treatment?

Please note the information provided is a guide and not an exact timeframe.

Following surgery the body will be going through a 4 step healing process. Often even when the skin looks healed deep down in the skin the body is still working hard to repair.

We advise all clients to wait at **least** 6 months following surgery before they make an appointment. Often 12/24 months is the optimum time as it allows you the patient time to fully heal and be ready for treatment, both inside and out.

Scars and Skin will change dramatically during the healing process. The best possible home care treatment we recommend is Massage. Massage as a home care treatment will aid in the overall healing and look of the scar.

Please note rushing into treatment when the skin is not fully healed can delay and potentially cause more trauma.

Areola tattooing - this client received a treatment to create a brand new nipple following breast cancer and reconstruction. We create these nipples on one side to mirror the existing nipple, or on both side if a bilateral treatment was performed.



Scar Camouflage - this client has received two treatments to rebuild a normal circular shape areola. Over two sessions we implanted pigment into the skin. (Image left: Top picture; before, Bottom Left; before, Bottom middle; healed after 1 session, Bottom right; straight after second session).



Scar revision - this client received 3 treatments to help reduce the look and feel of these self harm scars. Microneedling as a treatment triggers the bodies cell building processes, meaning you are strengthening and rebuilding skin. Skin colour can be improved through this treatment too, making a white scar less visible.
